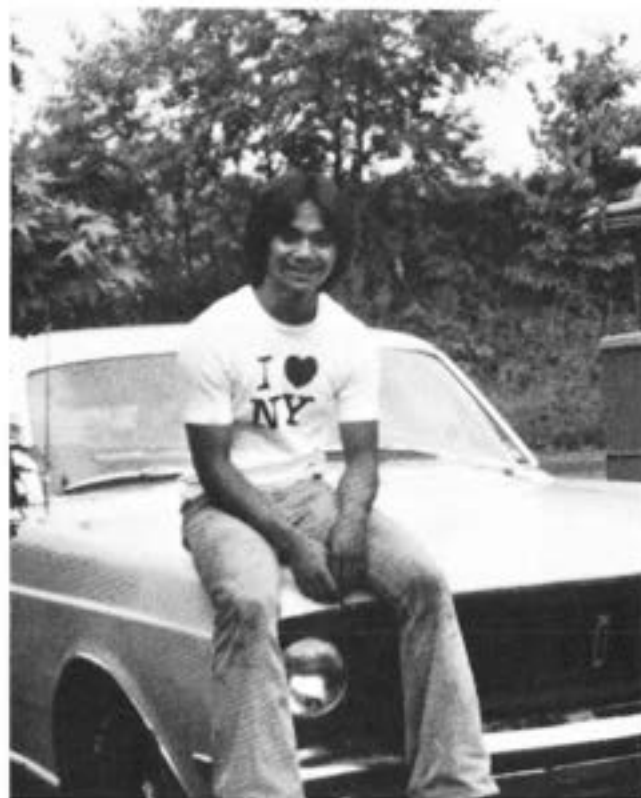


Camera Shy
