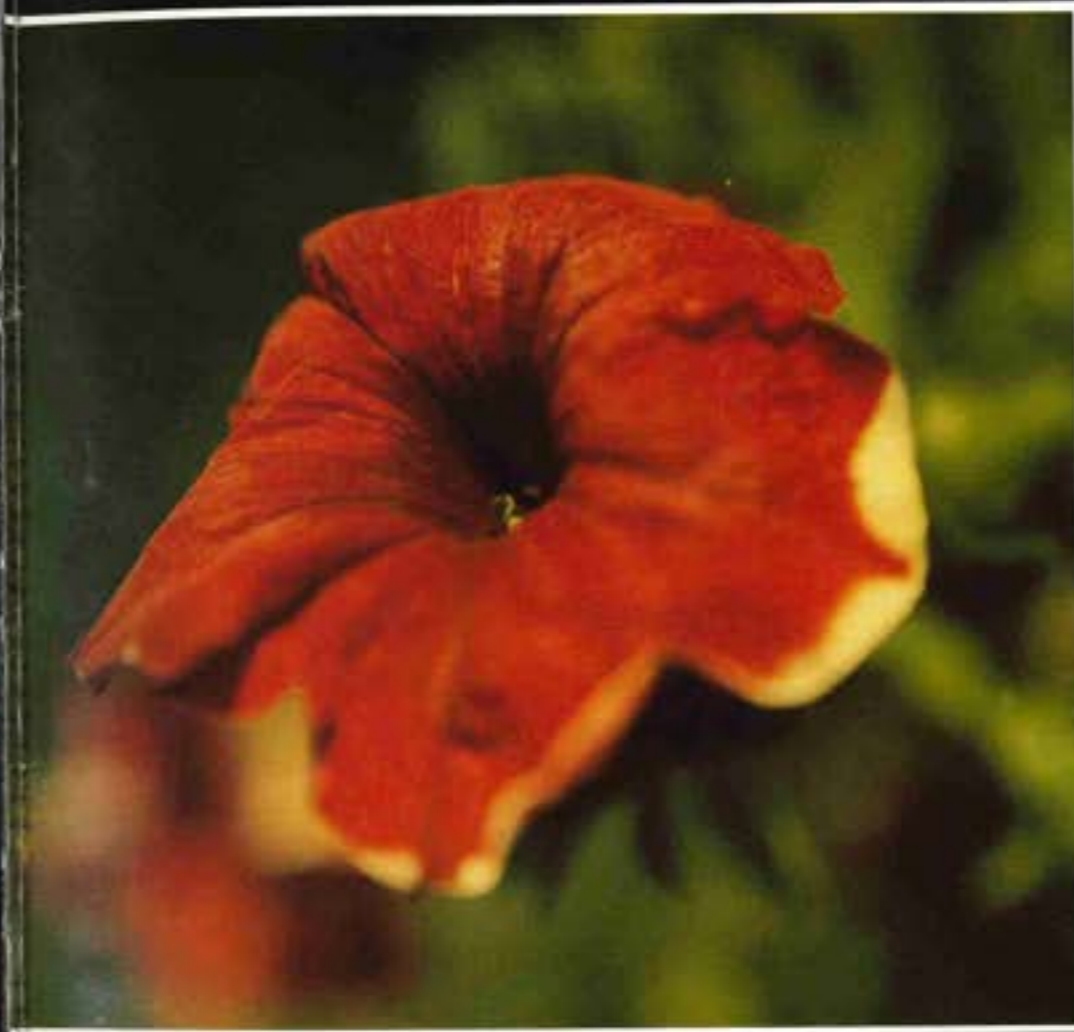


God's Gift

Juniors Take the Picnic



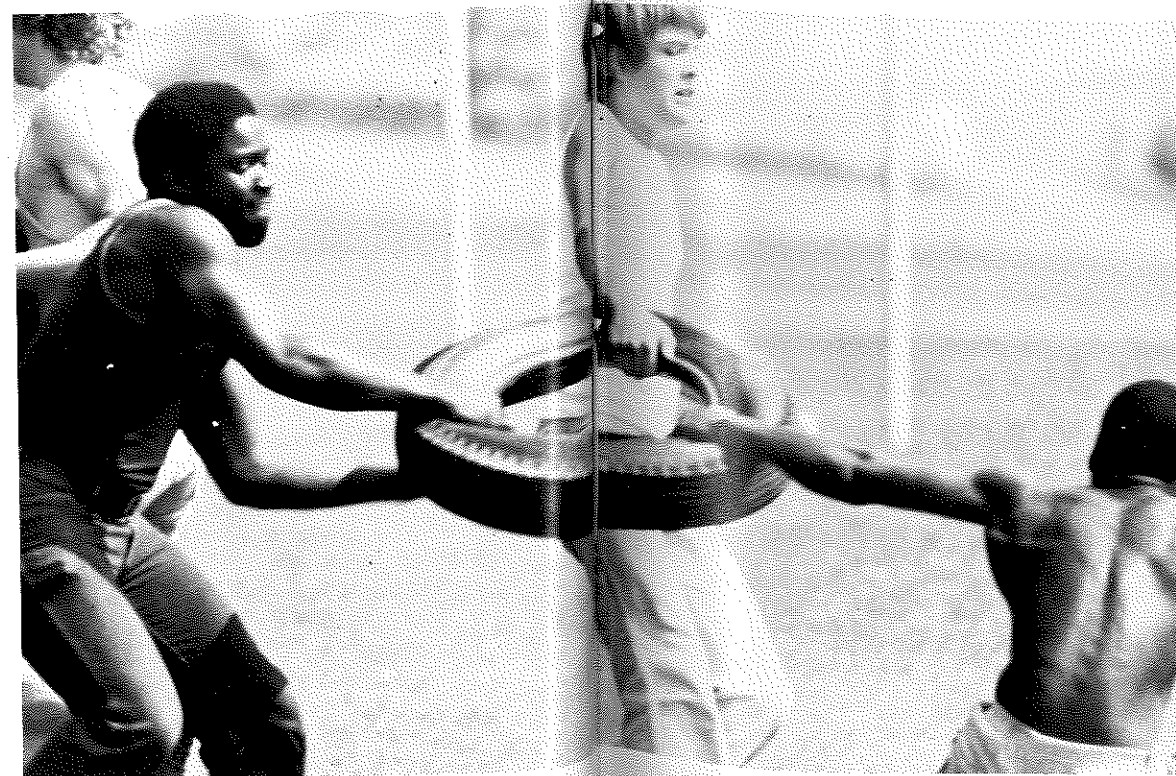

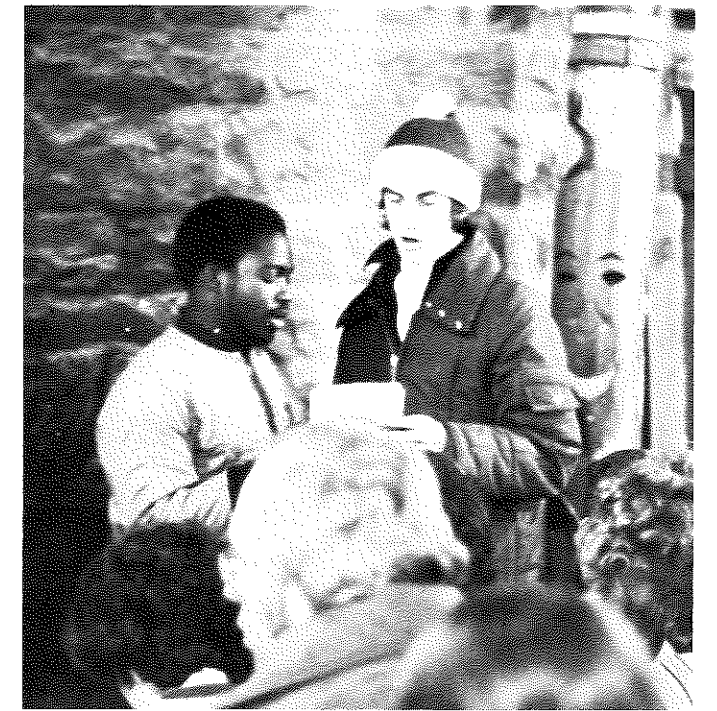
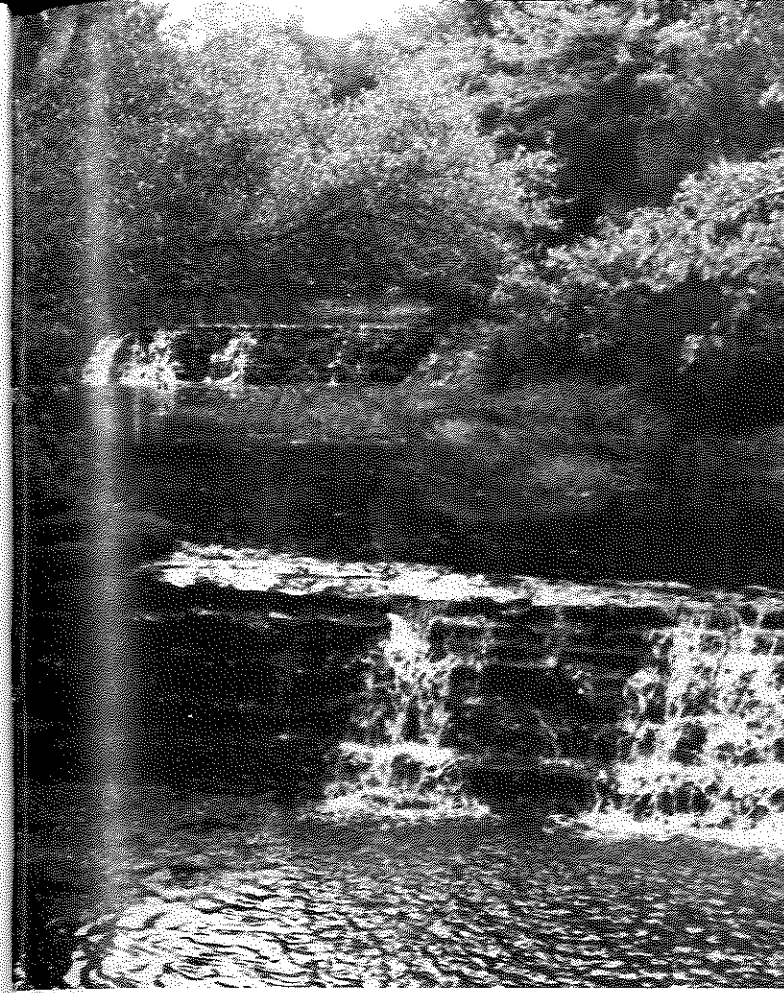

This year, for the Open House Banquet, our school, after gathering in the cafeteria, proceeded with quiet music and candlelight. Our cafeteria was decorated like a castle.

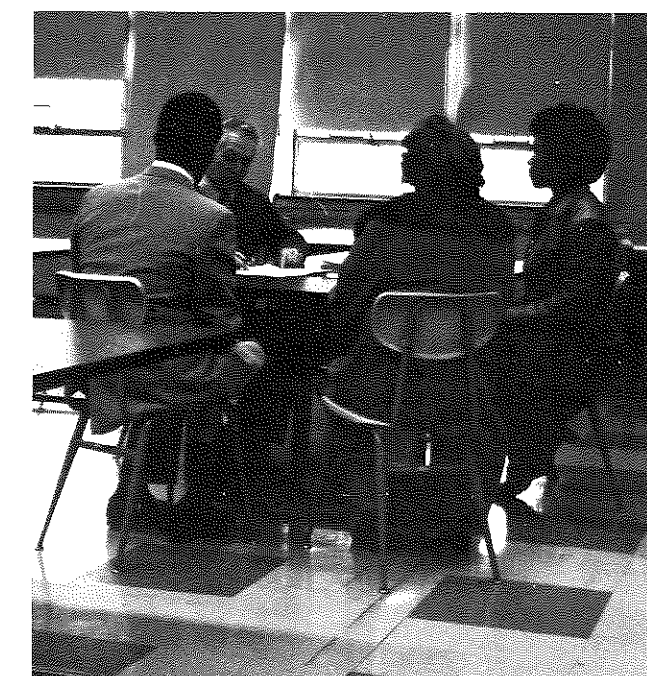
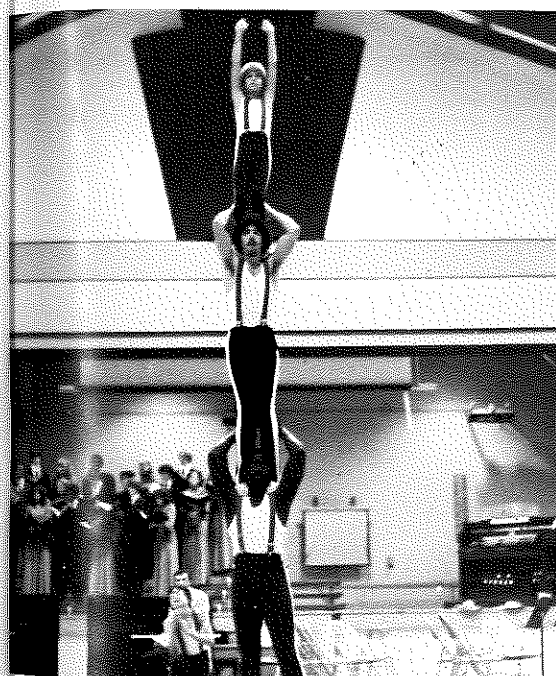

Parents Visit

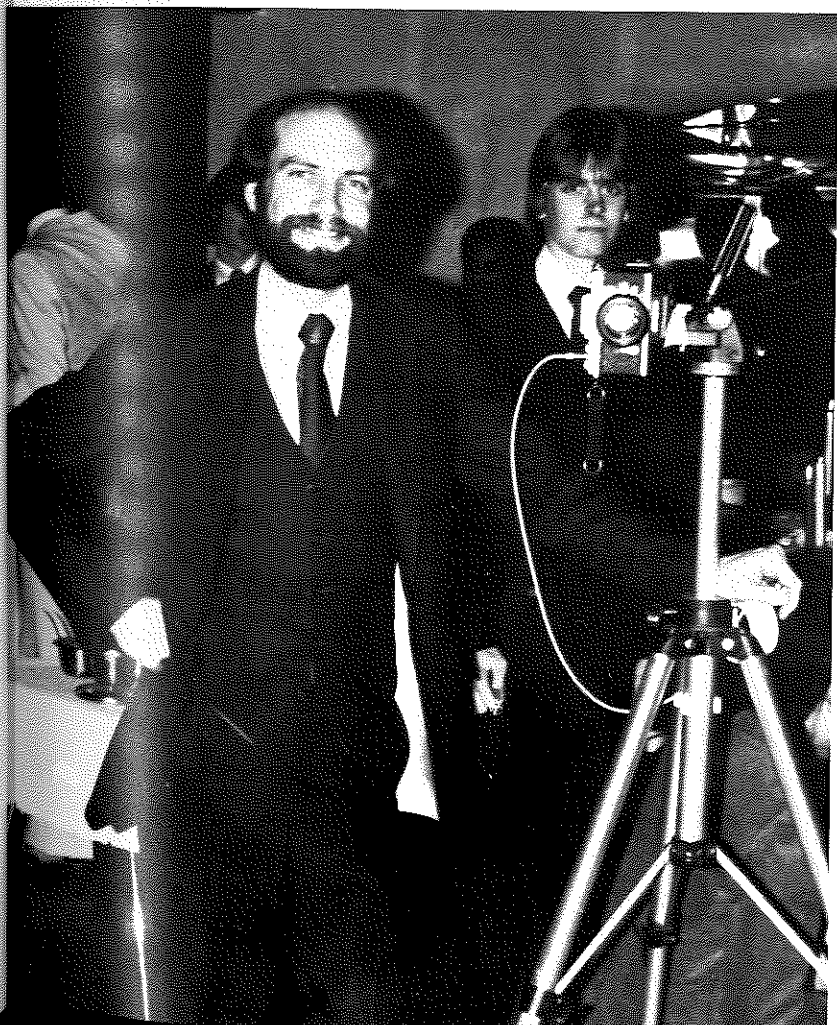
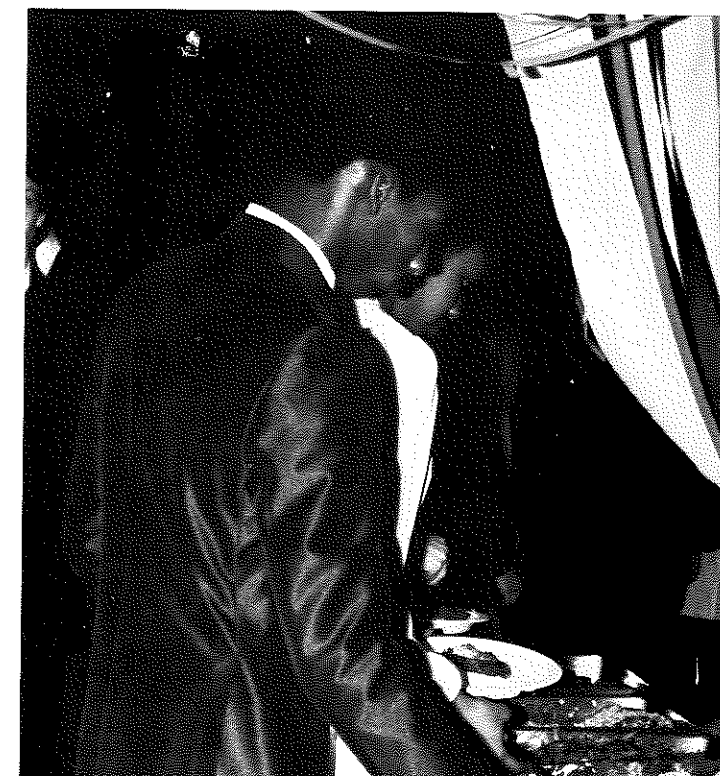
