

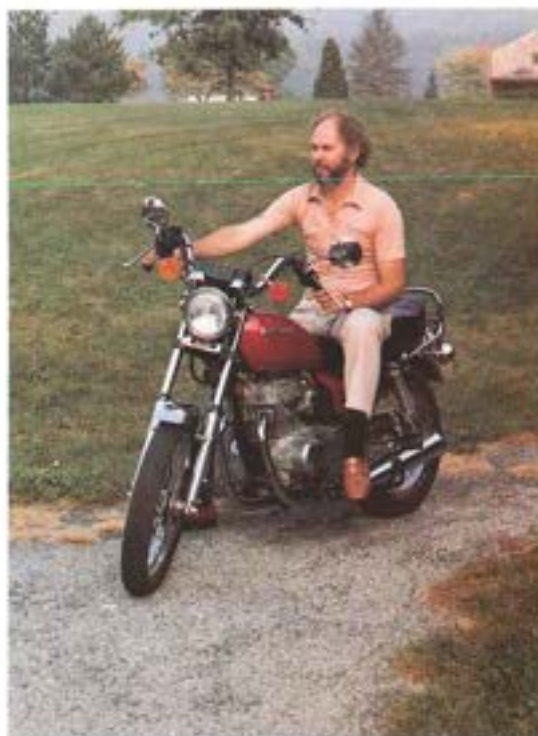

PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE



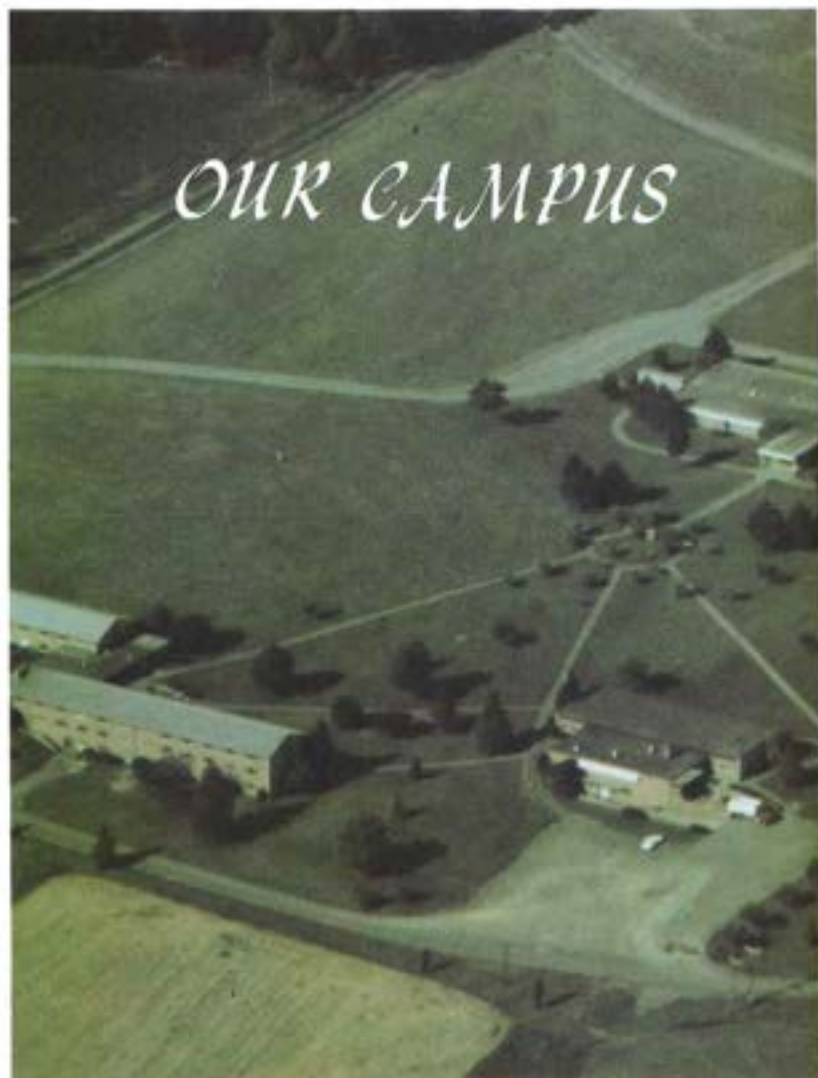
This year faculty and students alike have experienced the good and the bad that inevitably come with each school year. We thank God that this year we have seen more good days than bad!

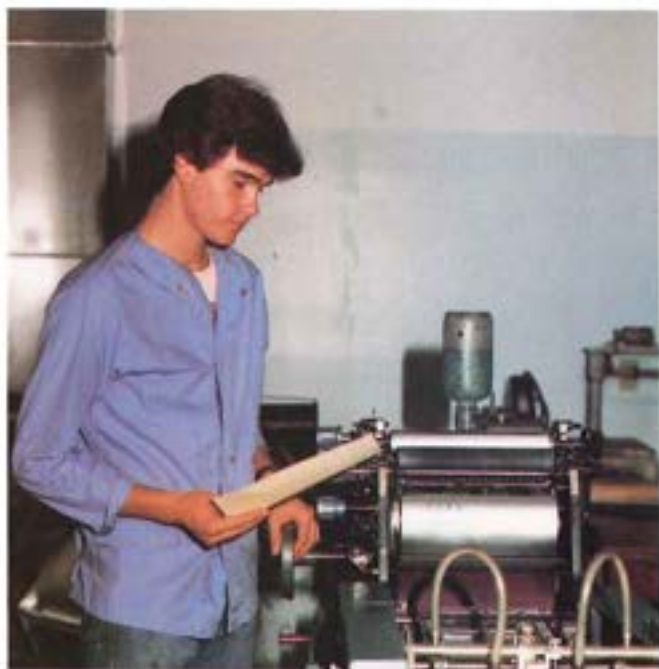

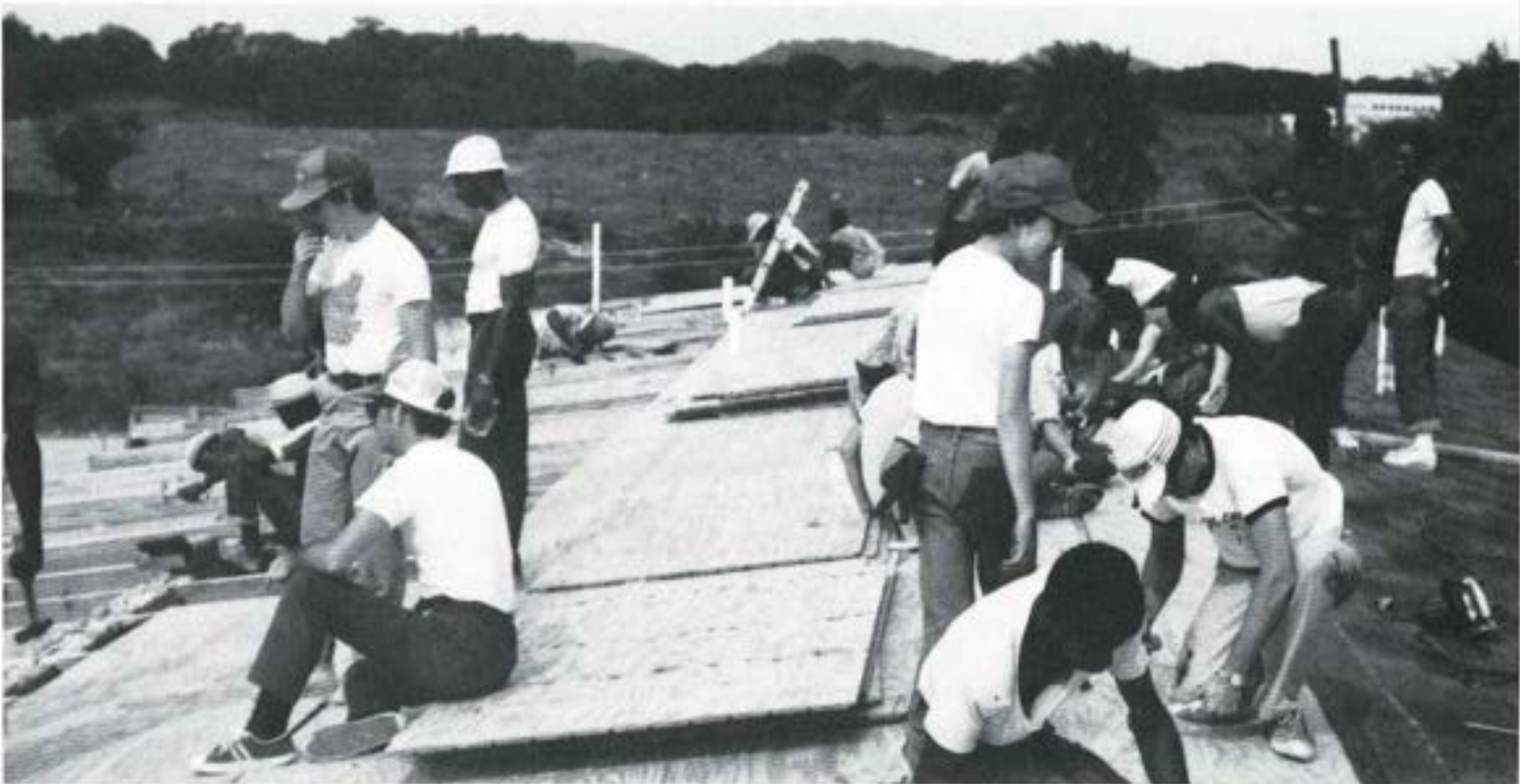

On December 27, 1982, while many were still celebrating Christmas, at least 50 homes were disturbed and rather than continue Christmas, how about bid a member of your family a good flight to the island of Antigua?

It was on that cool December 28th morning that we really started out. All 50 of us were of the J.F.K. Airport. About 15 of us would go to Dominica to build a S.D.A. school. It was this privilege of building a new S.D.A. school for the people of Antigua that Blue Mountain Academy participated in. Antigua is 108 square miles and is located in the heart of the Caribbean.

The island had ideal climate temperatures averaging between 76°F and 83°. Rainfall is 45 inches per year with the average humidity of 79%. Antigua has a population of over 70,000 people-quite a bit smaller than Philadelphia.

Of course, there is so much to say about Antigua, but as I reflect back onto the 2 weeks that we were in Antigua, all the hard work, much experience with less facilities, different foods, and getting to know many warm and friendly people, we were very sad to leave. As we said good-bye, tears came to all of our eyes, but we will always have addresses and a love for Jesus that someday soon we can meet again-if not on this earth-in the new earth to come

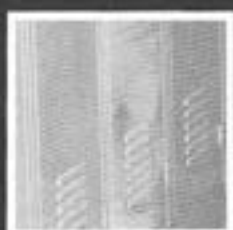
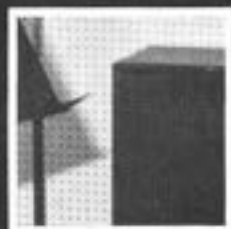
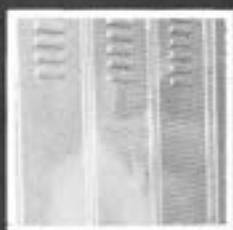


AMATEUR HOUR
