





All together fo so long makes us feel as we are one though strangers from the start we are now friends what we do and where we go will not matter in the end for we're following in the footprints of our Lord.





When second semester came around we were again allowed to choose a Sabbath School class. Some preferred to choose a new class for various reasons, while others chose to stay.




