To the *BMA Faculty* -- Keep up the good work with teaching and leading everyone here on campus. You have done a great job throughout my four years here.

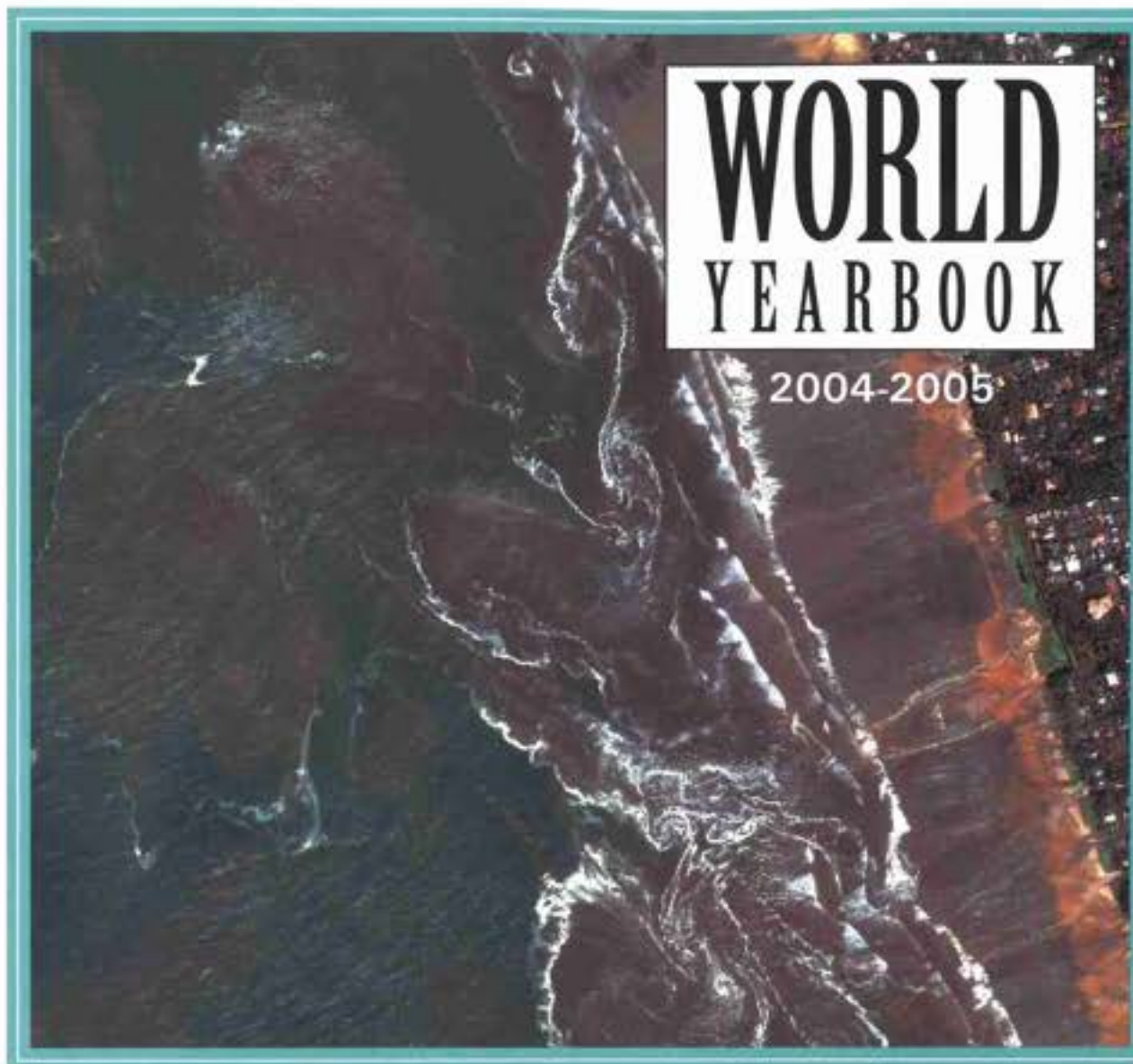
