details, and your humor always brightens our days here.

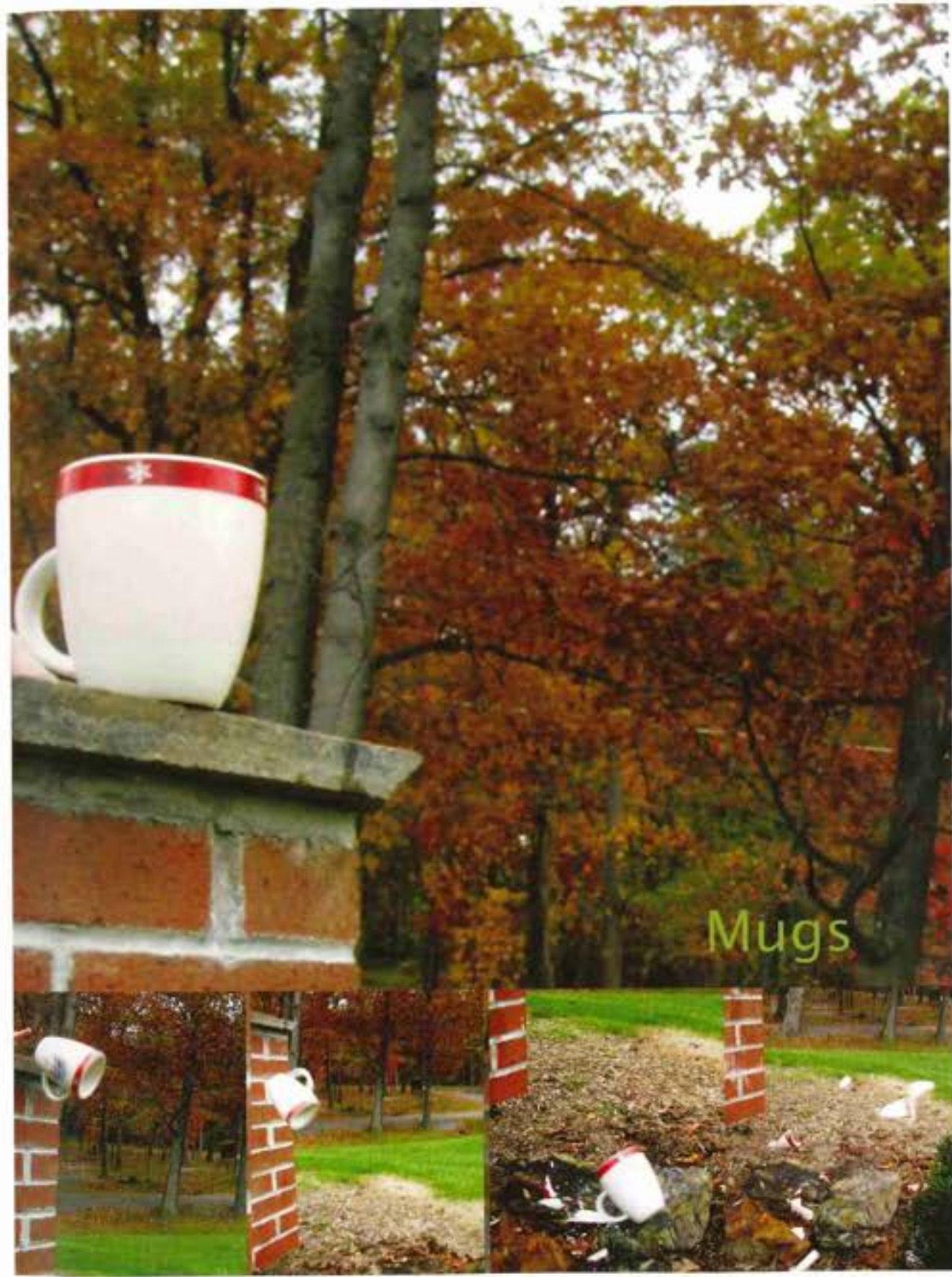
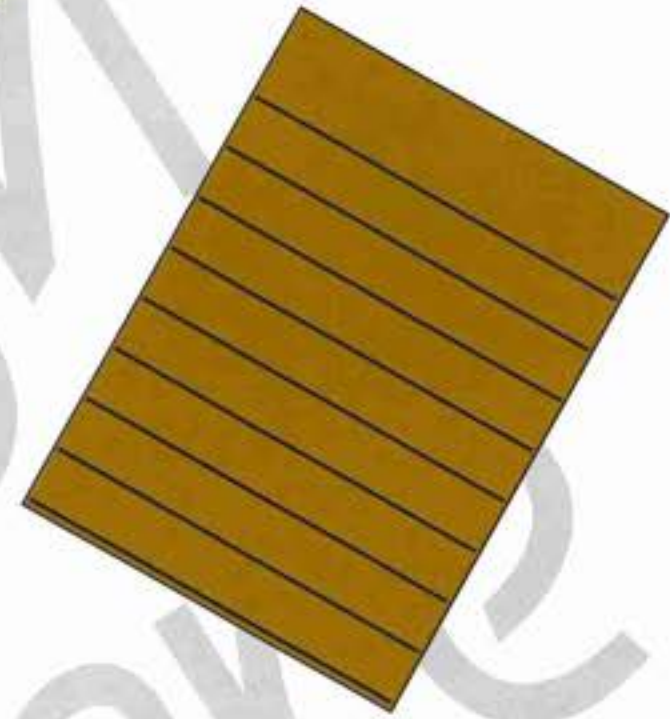
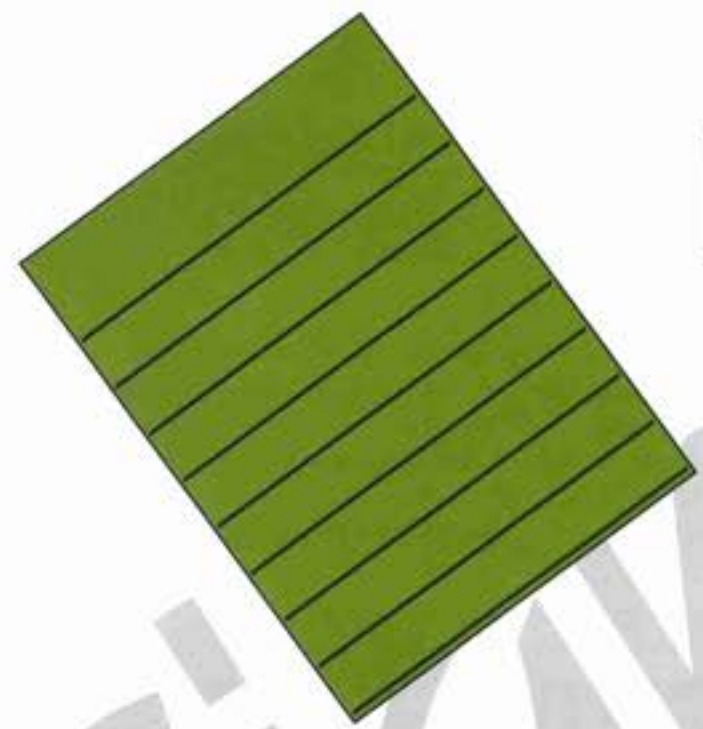
