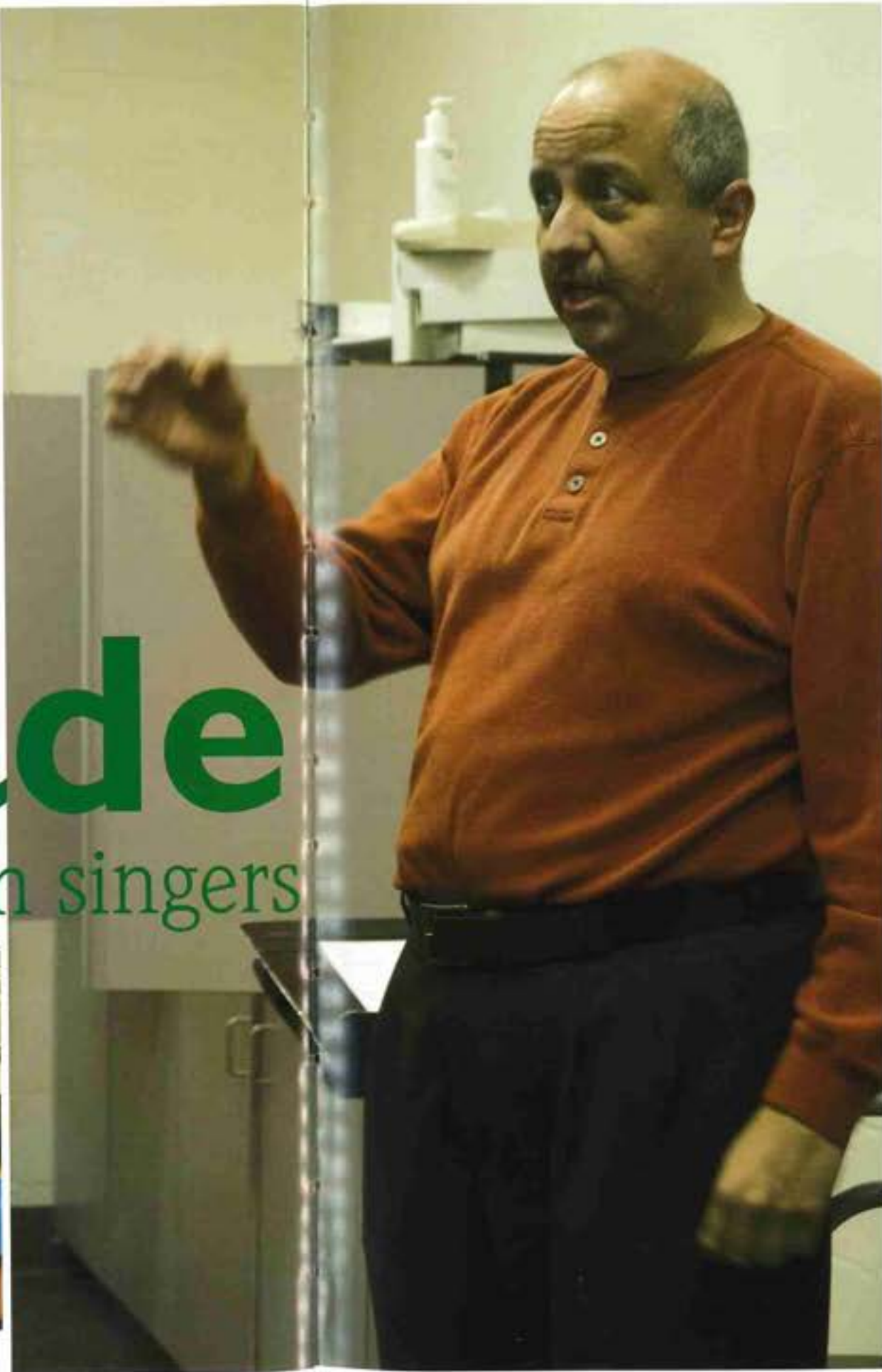

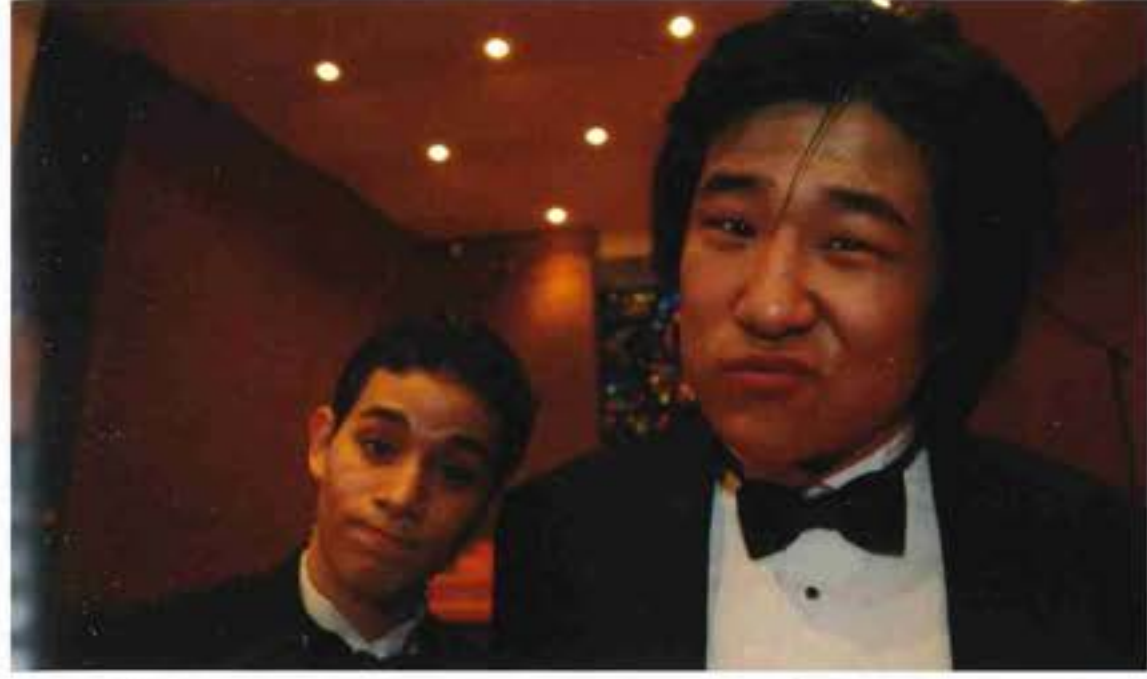

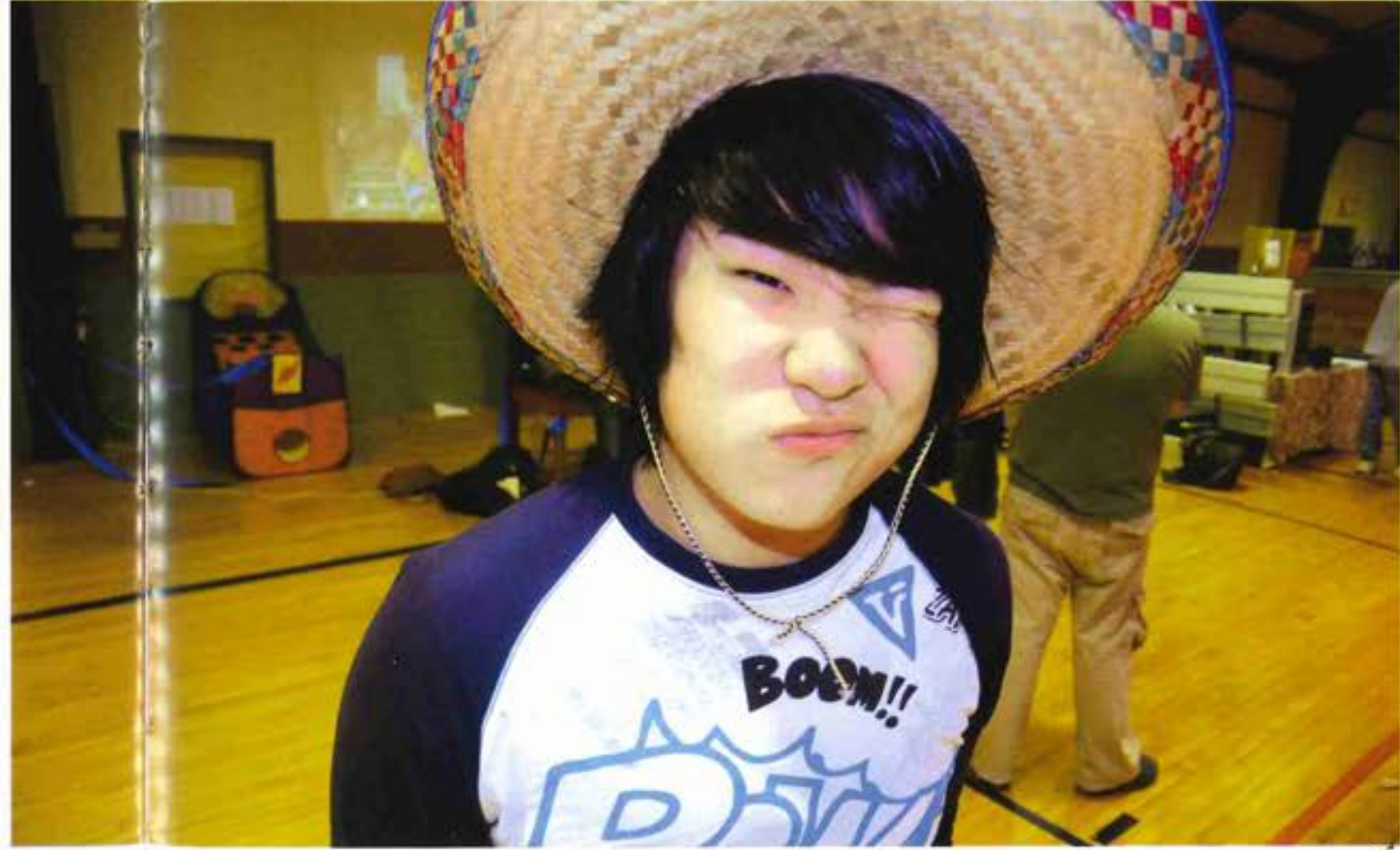
The evening began with a bit of confusion and transitioned into Pastor Dave leading a bit of a class rally. Cheers of "09!" rang out through the crowd.
