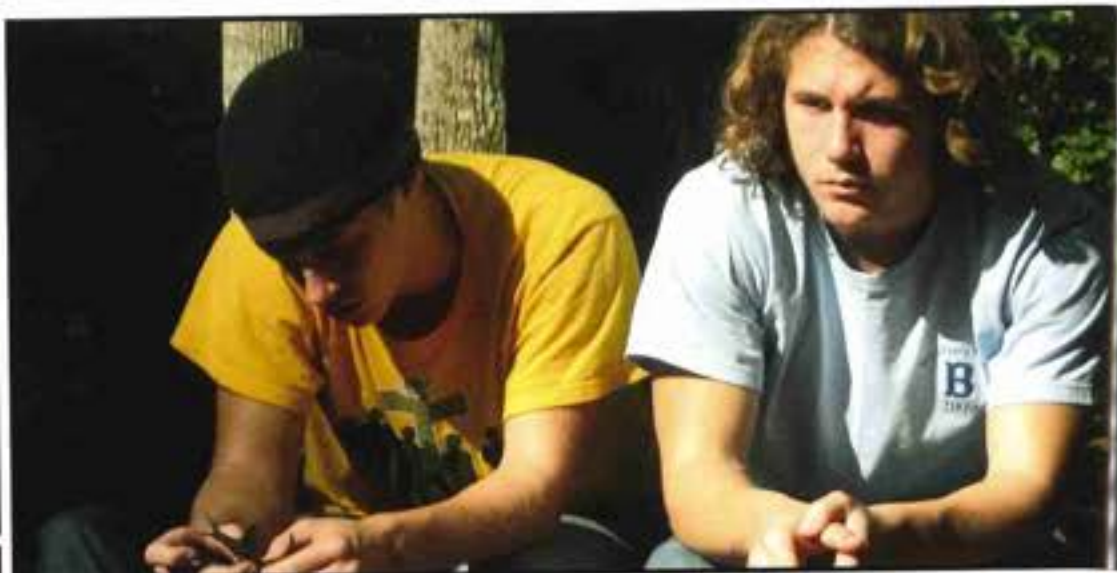
# Fall Festival

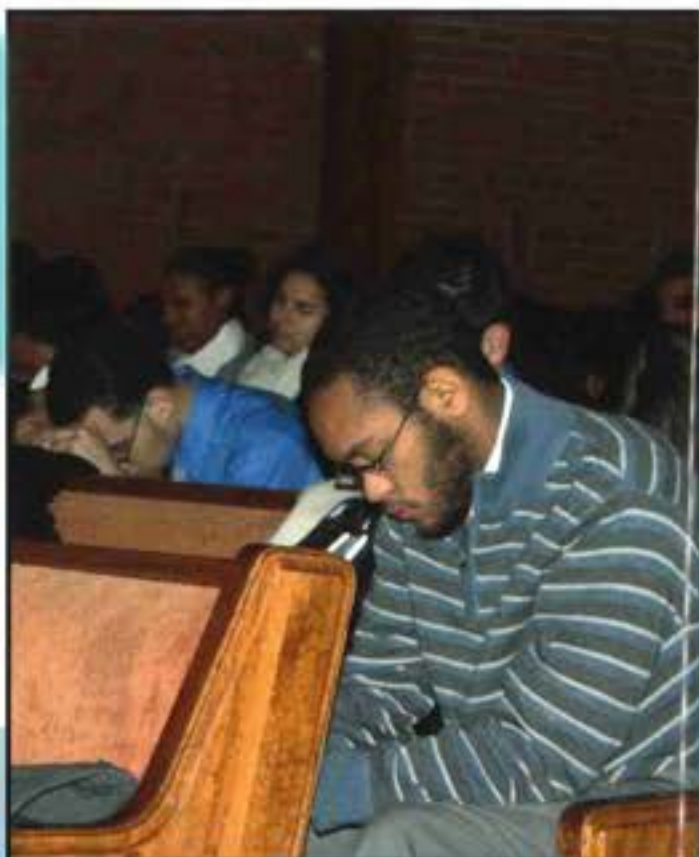

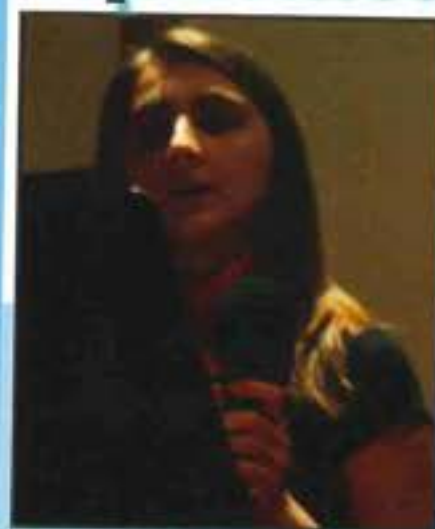

# BMA Leadership retreat

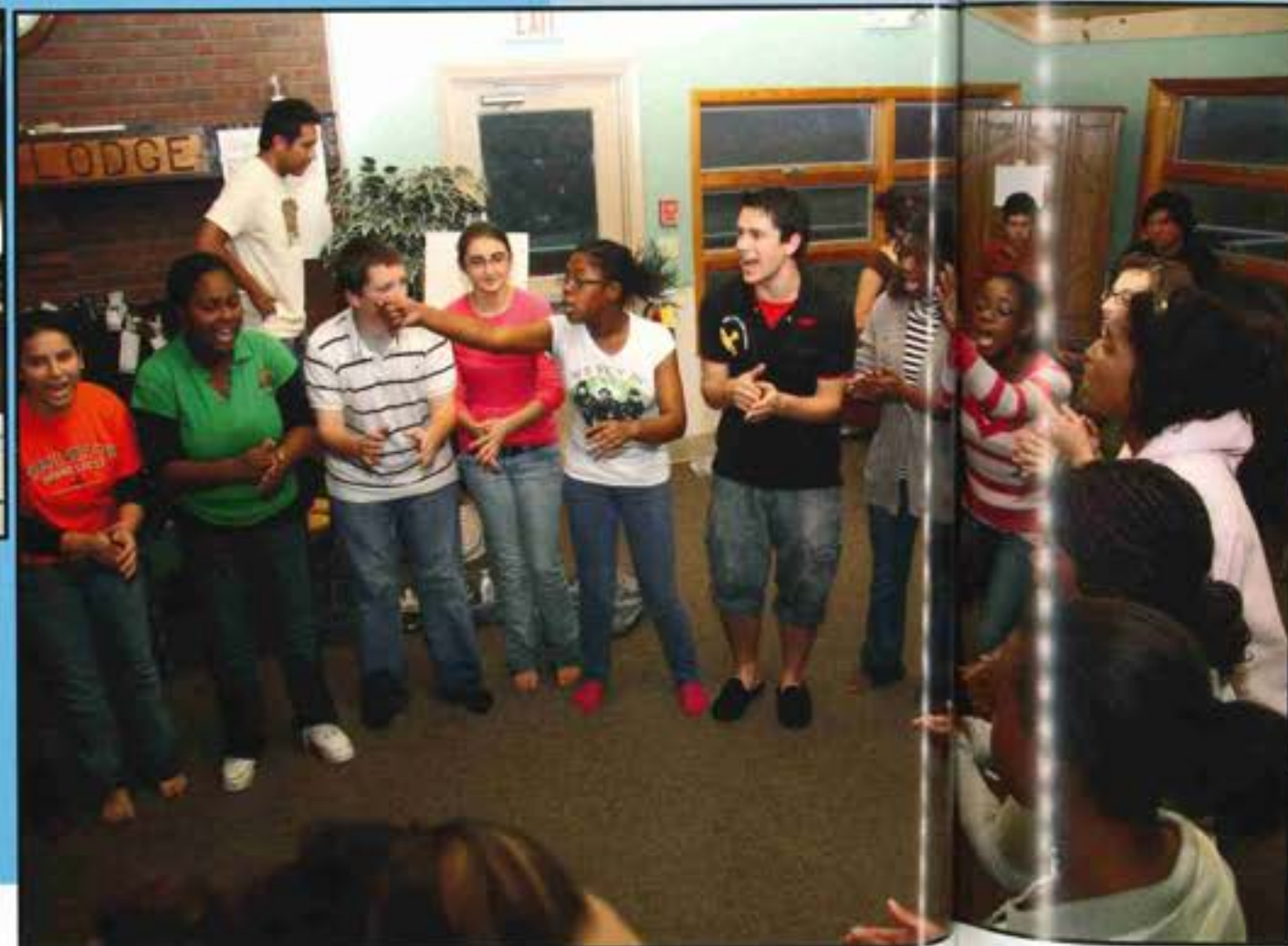

Since prayer is probably one of the biggest ways to communicate with God, here are some simple, noncliche twists to help you out of that rut.

Pray Through Written Words - Write your prayers, then over time go back and review what you've written and see how God has responded over time.

Pray with Emotion - God can handle your emotions. Use them as a booster rocket for prayer. Laugh out a prayer. Cry out a prayer. Connecting with God at this level is the very best place to find emotional wholeness.
