"Commit your works to the Lord, and your thoughts will be established". Prov. 16:3

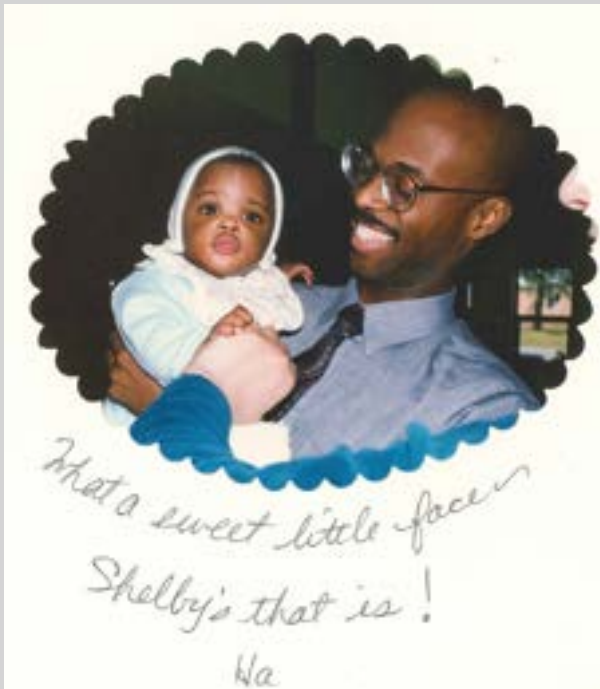


