Cling fast to Christ's two commands- love God above all else, and others as yourself.

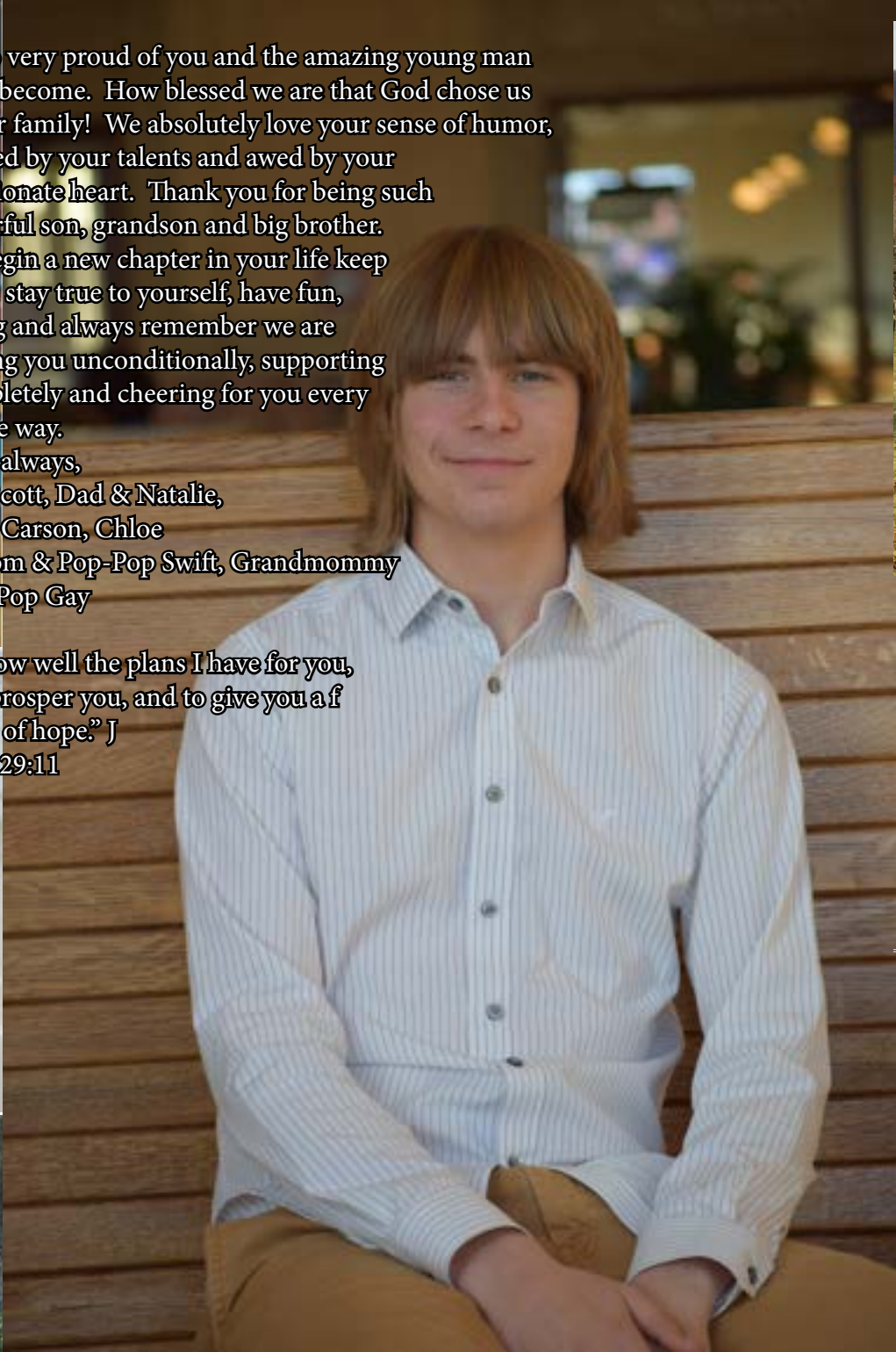
